

ZDAP Pre-Meeting
Bali, 5-6 November 2018

Launched in February 2014, the Global Health Security Agenda (GHSA) facilitates the vision of attaining a world safe and secure from global health threats posed by infectious diseases. A five year collaborative, multisectoral initiative (2014-2019) was launched that provides a means for countries, regions, international organizations, and the non-governmental sector (including the private sector) to accelerate and optimize global health security. Currently, 65 participating countries, 9 international and regional multilateral organizations and institutions, and non-governmental sector partners – including over 100 private companies, non-governmental organizations, and academic institutions – are part of the GHSA.

To facilitate regional and global collaboration toward specific GHSA objectives and targets, in 2014, 11 Action Packages were established to facilitate international discussion towards achieving specific, coordinated actions in support of the GHSA.

The Zoonotic Diseases Action Package (ZDAP), as one of the Action Packages, has the purpose of strengthening the capacities of GHSA participating countries, to detect, prevent, and respond to global public health threats, mainly zoonotic diseases that could cause an outbreak, pandemic or Public Health Emergency of International Concern (PHEIC).

Indonesia, Senegal and Vietnam, as the current co-lead countries for ZDAP, have agreed to the organise a series of successive annual meetings, bringing together lead and contributing countries and other key related stakeholders and interested partners. These successive meetings have facilitated discussions and sharing of experiences, raised common issues and proposed effective approaches by participants. A five-year global ZDAP Action Plan (2015-2019) and next steps for implementation at country, regional and global levels, including tracking of overall ZDAP efforts and progress for reporting to international GHSA ministerial meetings, was also developed.

Over the five-year period from 2014 to 2019, ZDAP has fostered the development and sharing of guidance, accomplishments, policies and practices to minimize the spill-over, spread, and emergence of zoonotic diseases in or out of human populations prior to the development of efficient human-to-human transmission. As it was agreed by the 2017 'Kampala Declaration' to extend the GHSA to 2024, Indonesia will host the 5th GHSA Ministerial Meeting: "Advancing Global Partnerships" in November 2018. Therefore, it is considered appropriate for ZDAP partners to hold a pre-meeting and side event during the November GHSA Meeting.

General Objectives

- To review progress made, lessons learned and identify activities needed to strengthen and fully implement the ZDAP Action Plan 2014-2019.
- To discuss ZDAP membership and support for the GHSA Framework 2019-2024;

Expected Outcomes

- i. Information shared on ZDAP achievements, challenges, lessons learned and best practices;
- ii. Identification of collaborative activities in 2019 to enhance coordination mechanisms to advance ZDAP partnership; and
- iii. Agreement reached on ZDAP within the GHSA 2024 Framework.

The ZDAP pre-Meeting will be organised in Bali, Indonesia on 5-6 November 2018.
