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# The Global Threat

- The 1918 Influenza Pandemic
  - Infected 500 million people (~one third of the world population)
  - Killed 50-100 million (3 times the number killed in World War I)
- Outbreaks Continue
  - Examples: SARS (2002), H1N1 influenza (2009), MERS-CoV (2012), H7N9 influenza (2013), Ebola (2014), Zika (2016)
  - Many others: Yellow fever, Chikungunya, dengue, cholera, etc.
- Risks to national, economic, and health security

# What is GHSA?

## Vision:

- A world safe and secure from global health threats posed by infectious diseases, whether natural, deliberate, or accidental

## A voluntary initiative launched in 2014 to:

- Enhance country capacities to prevent, detect, and respond
- Emphasize global health security as a national leader-level priority
- Promote multisectoral engagement and collaboration
- Focus on common, measurable targets

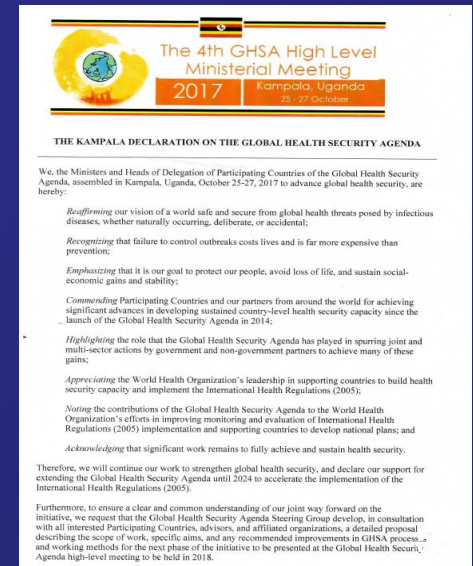
*Currently includes: 65 member countries, along with multilateral organizations, and non-governmental stakeholders*



# Beyond the First Five Years

In 2017, GHSA member countries at the Ministerial Meeting in Uganda endorsed the **Kampala Declaration**:

- Highlighting the role of GHSA in spurring action toward global health security;
- Acknowledging much work remains to achieve and sustain health security;
- Supporting extension of GHSA until 2024 to continue efforts; and
- Initiating a multilateral consultative process to develop the next phase of GHSA.





# Developing the Next Phase of GHSA

The Steering Group led a consultative process to develop a framework for “GHSA 2024”

- GHSA community-wide **questionnaire**
- Series of **virtual Town Hall webinars** hosted for difference time zones
- Updates and timelines shared on **GHSagenda.org**
- Three rounds of **review and comments** solicited from the GHSA community-wide



# Approach and Milestones

- **Overall Approach: Consultations, Drafts, Discussions**
- **Development Timeline**
  - **Nov 2017:** GHSA-wide input solicitation (Questionnaire)
  - **Dec 2017:** Discuss key issues at the Steering Group meeting
  - **Jan 2018:** Begin drafting; discuss further at Steering Group meeting
  - **Mar 2018:** Share 1<sup>st</sup> draft GHSA-wide; hold virtual Town Hall Meetings
  - **Apr 2018:** Incorporate input; draft Terms of Reference documents (TORs)
  - **May 2018:** Discuss Framework & TORs at Steering Group meeting
  - **Jul 2018:** Share 2<sup>nd</sup> draft GHSA-wide; hold virtual Town Hall Meetings
  - **Aug 2018:** Finalize Framework; partners indicate interest in roles for 2019
  - **Fall 2018:** Select new leads for GHSA 2024
  - **Nov 2018:** **Launch GHSA 2024 at the GHSA Ministerial Meeting**
  - **Dec 2018:** **Transition to GHSA 2024**



# Background and Goals

- **2017 Kampala Declaration**
  - **Endorsed** extension of GHSA to 2024
  - **Tasked the Steering Group to develop a** framework for the next phase of GHSA
- **Goals for “GHSA 2024”**
  - **Aims to achieve** ambitious but realistic goals
  - **Establishes an** approach to achieve those goals
  - **Incorporates** input from the broader GHSA community
  - **Launches at the** November GHSA Ministerial meeting





# GHSA 2024 Goal and Target

## Goal:

Work with relevant partners to support countries in evaluation, planning, resource mobilization, and implementation of activities that build health security capacity.

## Target:

More than 100 countries:

- Undergo health security capacity evaluation, national action planning, and resource mobilization, and begin implementing activities;
- Demonstrate improvements in at least 5 technical areas to a level of 'Demonstrated Capacity,' as measured by assessments (e.g., WHO).



# GHSA 2024 Framework

## I. Overarching Framework

- Vision, Mission, Core Principles, and Mandate
- Strategic Objectives
  - Promote international frameworks for health security
  - Strengthen multisectoral engagement and commitment
  - Support building capacities (e.g., tools, best practices)
  - Increase financial sustainability for health security
  - Strengthen accountability (members, commitments, etc.)
- Structure and Activities:
  - Steering Group, Secretariat Function, Task Forces, and Action Packages
  - GHSA-wide Activities (e.g., membership, meetings)
  - Tracking Progress and Impact
