

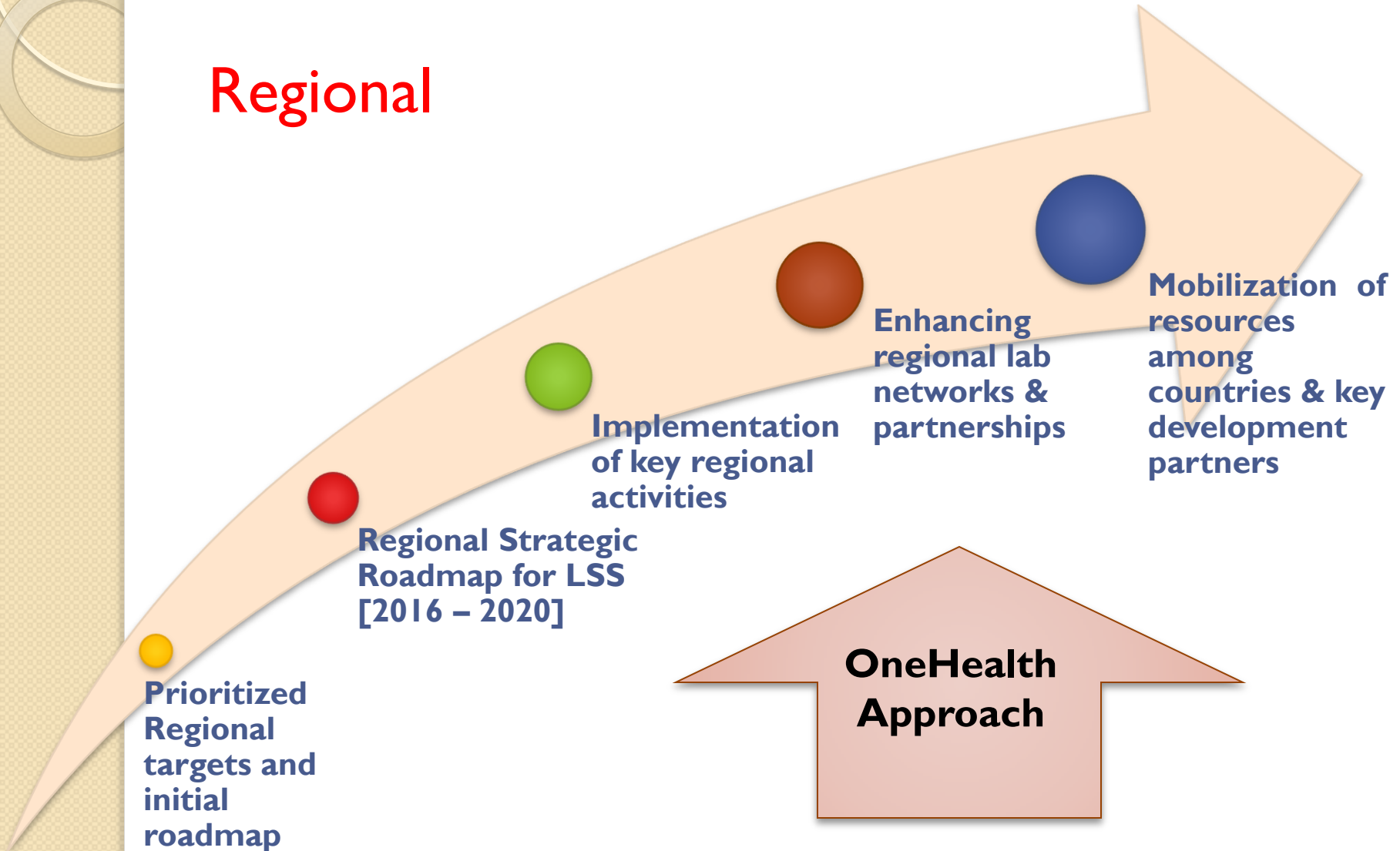

NATIONAL OPPORTUNITIES

[Example - Thailand]

- ❑ Strengthen national capacity to host/provide many of key regional workshops
- ❑ Utilize the Regional Strategic Roadmap for national improvement;
- ❑ Benefit of the Joint External Evaluation, conducted in June 2017;
 - ❑ JEE process enhanced the collaboration among key stakeholders
 - ❑ Strong commitments from high level
 - ❑ Gaps have been identified for further improvement
 - ❑ Accelerate an implementation of IHR

CHALLENGES

- ❑ Roles and responsibilities of leading countries & contributing countries should be clearly identified
- ❑ Working mechanisms – steering committee, AP coordination, national focal points – should be clarified/identified
- ❑ National commitments should be more clear
- ❑ Collaboration and coordination must improve between Action Packages
- ❑ Better communication among lead countries as well as contributing countries

WAY FORWARD

- ❑ Expand collaboration/linkages to other relevant Action Packages such as D5 (Workforce development) , P1 (AMR), P2 (Zoonotic Diseases), and P3 (Biosafety and Biosecurity);
- ❑ Continue to work with lead countries & contributing countries in implementing the Regional Strategic Roadmap on LSS;
- ❑ Maintain regular communication and collaboration among lead & contributing countries, key partners and supporting organizations
